

1. Executive Summary

The Lalji Foundation is a charitable organization dedicated to transforming lives across Tanzania through impactful initiatives in healthcare, education, economic empowerment, and social welfare. Guided by a strong commitment to humanity, compassion, and equity, the Foundation has emerged as a key partner in national development efforts that support the most vulnerable groups in society.

The Lalji Foundation has launched a vital health initiative in collaboration with the Muhimbili Orthopaedic Institute (MOI) to sponsor surgeries for 30 children suffering from **hydrocephalus** and **spina bifida**, two life-threatening and disabling conditions affecting infants and young children in Tanzania.

Hydrocephalus and Spina Bifida in Tanzanian Children

Hydrocephalus is a condition where excess fluid builds up in the brain, while spina bifida is a birth defect where the spine doesn't form properly. In Tanzania, many children suffer from these conditions due to poor maternal nutrition (especially folic acid deficiency), limited prenatal care, and infections.

These conditions can cause physical disabilities, developmental delays, and even death if untreated. Children often face stigma, are excluded from school, and lack access to healthcare and assistive devices.

Through this program, the Foundation provides full medical sponsorship, including neurosurgical operations, post-operative care, and rehabilitation support, targeting children from low-income and underserved families

The Vice Chairman of Lalji Foundation, Mohamed Damji, said that it is a great humility and pride that we continue our mission to serve the most vulnerable in our communities. The partnership between the Lalji Foundation and Muhimbili Orthopaedic Institute (MOI) reflects what we stand for: compassion, commitment, and impact.

On behalf of the Muhimbili Orthopaedic Institute, **Dr Khamis Shaban** said, I extend my sincere appreciation to the Lalji Foundation for their generous and sustained support in treating children affected by hydrocephalus and spina bifida.

These conditions are not only medically complex but emotionally and financially overwhelming for families, especially those from low-income backgrounds. Many of the children we receive here come from remote regions, and without sponsorship, timely treatment would be out of reach.

- To provide life-saving surgical interventions to children with hydrocephalus and spina bifida.
- To reduce mortality and disability related to these conditions among low-income families.
- To support long-term rehabilitation and care services for affected children.
- To raise awareness and promote early diagnosis and treatment.

JAMII imeaswa kujenga utamaduni wa kuwa na moyo wa kujitolea kusaidia watu wenye uhitaji hasa wenye vichwa vikubwa na mgongo wazi.

Hali hiyo ni kutokana na wazazi wengi kushindwa kumudu gharama za matibabu ya ugonjwa huo.

Wito huo ulitolewa jana na Grace Mollel ambaye ni mmoja ya mzazi wa mtoto mwenye changamoto ya vichwa vikubwa, aliyefanyiwa upasuaji katika Taasisi ya Mifupa Muhimbili (MOI) kupitia ufadhili wa Taasisi ya Lalji Foundation.

Akizungumza baada ya upasuaji wa mtoto wake, aliishukuru Lalji Foundation kwa msaada huo kwa kuwa hakua na uwezo wa kumudu gharama za matibabu, hivyo kupitia msaada wao umefanikisha kurejesha tabasamu kwani mtoto wake amefanyiwa upasuaj na anaendelea na matibabu.

Aidha, alitoa wito kwa watu wenye uwezo kujitoa kusaidia watu wenye uhitaji maalum haswa watoto wenye changamoto ya vichwa vikubwa na mgongo wazi kwani wazazi wengi wenye watoto wenye changamoto hiyo hawana uwezo wa kumudu gharama za upasuaji.

Pia aliwashauri wazazi wa watoto wenye changamoto ya vichwa vikubwa kuwapeleka hospitalini mapema ili wapatiwe huduma za matibabu kwani kuwafungia ndani kunaweza kuleta athari kubwa zaidi.

Daktari Bingwa wa Ipasuaji wa Magonjwa ya Uti wa Mgongo na Mishipa ya Fahamu MOI, Hamisi Shabani, alisema tatizo la Vichwa kikubwa na mgongo wazi ni kubwa kiasi lakini kwa sasa limeanza kuonekana kwa wingi kutokana na uelewa wa jamii kuhusu tatizo hilo.

"Tunawashukuru watanzania ambao wameweza kutoa elimu mbalimbali kuhusu kuzuia unyanyapaa wa Watoto wenye matatizo ya vichwa vikubwa na mgongo wazi na idadi wa wazazi kuwapeleka watoto hospitali imekua inaridhisha kutokana na uelewa wa jamii kuhusu tatizo hilo," alisema

Alisema kwa wastani Tanzania inazalisha takribani watoto 4,000 wenye tatizo la vichwa vikubwa na mgongo wazi kwa mwaka kwa ikiwa ni kwa mujibu wa makisio ya sensa ya mwaka 2022 ambayo inafafanua kuwa takribani watoto 10,000 wanaozaliwa watoto watatu wanazaliwa na changamoto ya vichwa vikubwa na mgongo wazi.

Alisisitiza kuwa tatizo la vichwa vikubwa linazuilika kwa mama mjamzito endapo timu ya wataalamu itajiridhisha kuwa mama huyo hana tatizo la upungufu wa madini ya folic acid na akigundulika ana changamoto ya upungufu wa madini hayo basi atapewa vidonge kwaajili ya kuongeza madini hayo ambayo kwa kiasi kikubwa yanasaidia kuzuia tatizo hilo.

Makamu Mwenyekiti wa Taasisi ya Lalji Foundation, Mohamed Damji, alisema kwa kushrikiana na MOI wametoa msaada huo ili kusaidia watoto hao ambao wazazi wao hawana uwezo wa kumudu gharama za upasuaji ikiwa ni sehemu ya majukumu ya taasisi hiyo kusaidia watu wenye uhitaji.
