1. Executive Summary

The **Lalji Foundation** is a charitable organization dedicated to transforming lives across Tanzania through impactful initiatives in **healthcare**, **education**, **economic empowerment**, **and social welfare**. Guided by a strong commitment to humanity, compassion, and equity, the Foundation has emerged as a key partner in national development efforts that support the most vulnerable groups in society.

The Lalji Foundation implemented a life-changing Shallow Well Project in Busondo Village, Nzega District, to address the urgent need for access to clean and safe water. Before this intervention, the community relied on unsafe and distant water sources, which contributed to frequent waterborne illnesses and placed a heavy burden on women and children responsible for water collection.

To address this issue, the Shallow Well Project was implemented to provide a sustainable and locally managed water source, ensuring the health, hygiene, and dignity of the people of Busondo village.

2. Project Objectives

- To construct a shallow well that provides clean and safe water.
- To reduce the distance and time required to collect water, especially for women and children.
- To minimize cases of waterborne diseases.
- To establish a community-led water management structure for long-term maintenance.

- Meetings were held with village leaders and residents to promote ownership.
- A Village Water Committee was formed to oversee well use and maintenance.
- Community members were trained in hygiene and basic pump maintenance.

- Over 300 villagers now have daily access to clean and safe water.
- Women and children spend less time fetching water, enabling more time for school and economic activities.
- Community ownership of the well has increased responsibility and sustainability.
