1. Executive Summary

The **Lalji Foundation** is a charitable organization dedicated to transforming lives across Tanzania through impactful initiatives in **healthcare**, **education**, **economic empowerment**, **and social welfare**. Guided by a strong commitment to humanity, compassion, and equity, the Foundation has emerged as a key partner in national development efforts that support the most vulnerable groups in society.

The Lalji Foundation implemented a life-changing Shallow Well Project in kwamuhuzi Village, Mvumero District, to address the urgent need for access to clean and safe water. Before this intervention, the community relied on unsafe and distant water sources, which contributed to frequent waterborne illnesses and placed a heavy burden on women and children responsible for water collection.

Imtiaz Lalji, the Chairman of Lalji Foundation, emphasised the importance of access to clean and safe water during the commissioning of a shallow well in kwamuhuzi Village, Mvomero District, Morogoro. He urged the community to take good care of the project to ensure it benefits both the current and future generations.

Benson Mangula Chairman of kwamuhuzi village, in Mvomero District, Morogoro, thanked the Lalji Foundation for providing a shallow well, noting that the project will greatly ease access to clean and safe water for the community.

2. Project Objectives

- To construct a shallow well that provides clean and safe water.
- To reduce the distance and time required to collect water, especially for women and children.
- To minimize cases of waterborne diseases.
- To establish a community-led water management structure for long-term maintenance.

- A Village Water Committee was formed to oversee well use and maintenance.
- Community members were trained in hygiene and basic pump maintenance.

8. Impact on the Community

- Over 4700 villagers now have daily access to clean and safe water.
- Women and children spend less time fetching water, enabling more time for school and economic activities.
- Community ownership of the well has increased responsibility and sustainability.
