1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Lalji Foundation is a charitable organization focusing on education, women's empowerment, health, orphans and water-access projects. In 2025, it launched shallow water-access initiatives in Morogoro Region, including the construction and handover of a community well to residents of Dumila Juu Village.

Dumila Juu is a rural village in Dumila Ward, Kilosa District, Morogoro Region. The community relies heavily on small-scale farming and faces challenges related to safe and reliable water access, especially during dry seasons.

Ms. Judith Kahatano, Projects Coordinator of LALJI FOUNDATION, said that the completion of the shallow well at Dumila Juu Village reflects a strong commitment to improving access to clean and safe water for rural communities. She emphasized that the project is intended to ease the daily challenges faced by residents, particularly women and children, while promoting better health and dignity within the community.

Rest munis, Chairman of Dumila juu village, in Kilosa District, Morogoro, thanked the Lalji Foundation for providing a shallow well, noting that the project will greatly ease access to clean and safe water for the community.

- Provide a reliable and safe source of clean water for households and institutions.
- Reduce the time and physical burden spent fetching water, particularly for women and children.
- Improve community health by reducing waterborne diseases.

- Promote sustainable water management through local ownership and maintenance systems.

- Significant time savings for families, allowing more time for school and economic activities.
- Increased safety and reduced burden on women and children previously walking long distances for water.
- Strengthened community structures through participation in water management.
- Households using water for small-scale home gardens.
- Water Committee actively managing and maintaining the well.
- Community instructed on safeguarding the well to prolong its lifespan.
