### **1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The **Lalji Foundation** is a Tanzanian-based non-governmental organization dedicated to uplifting under-served communities across the country through strategic charitable and development initiatives. Founded by the Lalji family with a vision of fostering human dignity and self-sufficiency, the Foundation focuses on sustainable community impact through education, health, economic empowerment, and infrastructure support.

Historically, **Magomeni** Village developed as a settlement community supporting agricultural livelihoods, similar to many villages in Kilosa District. Population growth over time has been influenced by internal migration, as families moved into the area in search of arable land and better farming opportunities. The village's growth has been shaped by traditional land use practices, communal living, and local leadership structures.

The construction of a **shallow well at Muungano Primary School** has significantly improved access to clean and safe water for pupils, teachers, and the surrounding community. Before the project, the school faced challenges in obtaining reliable water, which affected hygiene, sanitation, and the overall learning environment.

The availability of clean water at the school has enhanced **health and sanitation standards**, including regular handwashing, proper use of latrines, and a cleaner school environment. This has contributed to reduced cases of water-related illnesses among pupils, leading to improved attendance and concentration in class.

**Mr Khamis Yahya**, LALJI FOUNDATION representative, reaffirmed its commitment to continue partnering with the government and communities to support development projects in areas with the greatest need. He emphasized the Foundation's dedication to expanding projects in water, Health and education

**Mr Erick Yusufu**, the Head master of Muungano Primary School in Magomeni village, expressed deep gratitude to the Lalji Foundation for its continued commitment to improving the lives of vulnerable communities in Tanzania. The work in areas such as clean water, education, health, and community empowerment has brought real and lasting change to many villages across the country.

## 2. PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- To provide access to clean and safe water for households in Magomeni Village through the construction of a shallow well.
- To reduce the incidence of waterborne diseases by minimizing reliance on unsafe and contaminated water sources.
- To reduce the time and physical burden spent by women and children in collecting water from distant sources.
- To improve hygiene and sanitation practices within the community by ensuring the availability of safe water for daily use.
- To strengthen community participation and ownership in the management, maintenance, and protection of the water source.
- To support socio-economic development by enabling households to allocate more time to productive and educational activities.

- The implementation of the project has generated significant positive impacts on the lives of the Magomeni Village community, particularly in relation to health, social welfare, and economic development.
- The availability of a reliable clean water source has significantly improved access to safe water for households in Magomeni Village.
- Access to clean water has contributed to a reduction in waterborne diseases such as diarrhea, cholera, and typhoid. This improvement has eased the burden on families and local health facilities, particularly benefiting children, the elderly, and pregnant women.
- Women and children, who traditionally bear the responsibility of fetching water, now spend less time and physical effort collecting water.
- Improved hygiene and Sanitation Practices with sufficient water available, households are better able to maintain proper hygiene and sanitation. This has led to cleaner living environments and improved public health awareness within the community.
- Community involvement in the planning, implementation, and management of the project has strengthened local ownership and responsibility.
- Socio-Economic Development reliable access to water supports small-scale economic activities such as farming, livestock keeping, and small businesses. This contributes to increased household income and improved food security in Magomeni Village.


