1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Lalji Foundation is a registered non-governmental organization (NGO) established in Tanzania by the Lalji family. Founded with a deep commitment to social good, the Foundation seeks to uplift vulnerable communities and improve the quality of life across multiple regions of the country, such as Education, Health, women's empowerment, community development and orphans

Mambegwa Village is a rural community within Kilosa District, where the majority of our people depend on agriculture and small-scale economic activities for their livelihoods. Like many rural villages, we face several development challenges, particularly in access to clean and safe water, education infrastructure, and health services. These challenges directly affect the wellbeing of our children, women, and the elderly.

Mr Khamis Yahya, LALJI FOUNDATION representative, reaffirmed its commitment to continue partnering with the government and communities to support development projects in areas with the greatest need. He emphasized the Foundation's dedication to expanding projects in water, Health and education

- To enhance public health by encouraging the use of clean water, improved sanitation practices, and hygiene awareness within the village
- To involve village leaders and community members in planning, implementation, and management of the project to ensure sustainability and accountability.
- To contribute to long-term socio-economic development by ensuring water availability for domestic use, small-scale farming, and income-generating activities.
- To foster collaboration between Mambegwa Village, Lalji Foundation, and local government authorities for effective and sustainable development interventions.

- Access to clean water will lead to a decrease in illnesses such as diarrhea, cholera, and typhoid, improving overall community health and reducing medical expenses.

- Women and children will spend less time fetching water from distant sources, allowing children to attend school regularly and women to engage in productive and income-generating activities.
- With reduced household water responsibilities, children, especially girls will have more time and energy for education, leading to improved attendance and academic performance.
- The availability of clean water will promote better hygiene behaviors, including handwashing and cleanliness at household and community levels.
- Community involvement in the project will foster a sense of ownership, responsibility, and cooperation among residents, strengthening local leadership and social cohesion.
- Reliable water access will support small-scale farming, livestock care, and micro-business activities, contributing to increased household incomes.
- Proper management and maintenance of the water facility will ensure long-term benefits for current and future generations, enhancing community resilience to drought and climate variability.
