### **1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The **Lalji Foundation** is a non-profit organization committed to improving the lives of vulnerable communities through sustainable and impactful development initiatives. With a strong focus on compassion, dignity, and empowerment, the foundation works to address key social challenges in areas such as education, water access, and community welfare.

Access to clean water remains a major challenge in many rural parts of Kilosa District, particularly in Kondoa Village. Residents, especially women and children, often travel long distances to access water from unsafe sources, exposing them to waterborne diseases and limiting time for education and economic activities.

Recognizing this need, the **Lalji Foundation** initiated the Kondoa Shallow Well 009 project as part of its broader commitment to community development and sustainable solutions.

- To improve hygiene and sanitation practices within the community by ensuring the availability of safe water for daily use.
- To strengthen community participation and ownership in the management, maintenance, and protection of the water source.
- To support socio-economic development by enabling households to allocate more time to productive and educational activities.

- The implementation of the project has generated significant positive impacts on the lives of the Kondoa Village community, particularly in relation to health, social welfare, and economic development.
- The availability of a reliable, clean water source has significantly improved access to safe water for households in Kondoa Village.
- Access to clean water has contributed to a reduction in waterborne diseases such as diarrhea, cholera, and typhoid. This improvement has eased the burden on families and local health facilities, particularly benefiting children, the elderly, and pregnant women.
- Women and children, who traditionally bear the responsibility of fetching water, now spend less time and physical effort collecting water.
- Improved hygiene and Sanitation Practices with sufficient water available, households are better able to maintain proper hygiene and sanitation. This has led to cleaner living environments and improved public health awareness within the community.
- Community involvement in the planning, implementation, and management of the project has strengthened local ownership and responsibility.
- Socio-Economic Development reliable access to water supports small-scale economic activities such as farming, livestock keeping, and small businesses. This contributes to increased household income and improved food security in Kondoa Village.
