1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Lalji Foundation is a charitable organization based in Tanzania that is dedicated to improving the lives of vulnerable and underserved communities through sustainable social development initiatives. Founded by the Lalji family, the Foundation focuses on creating long-term impact in areas such as education, healthcare, clean water access, community development, women empowerment, and support for orphans and families in need.

Through its humanitarian programs, the Foundation has implemented projects including boreholes and shallow wells, school support initiatives, medical assistance, food distribution, and economic empowerment activities across different regions of Tanzania. Guided by compassion, unity, and social responsibility, the Lalji Foundation works closely with communities and development partners to bring hope, dignity, and opportunity to those most in need.

Makuyu Village is one of the rural communities found in Mvomero District, an area known for its rich agricultural activities, cultural diversity, and growing rural development initiatives. Historically, the people of Mvomero District have depended mainly on agriculture and livestock keeping as their primary economic activities. Communities in the area cultivate crops such as maize, rice, cassava, beans, sunflower, and vegetables, while some residents engage in cattle keeping and small-scale trade.

This important initiative aims to reduce water shortages, improve sanitation and hygiene, and protect residents from waterborne diseases.

For many families in Makuyu Village, access to reliable clean water has been a major challenge, especially for women and children who often travel long distances in search of water. The newly donated shallow well will help ease this burden by providing a sustainable and accessible source of safe water for daily domestic use.

Mr Imtiaz Lalji, Chairman of LALJI FOUNDATION, reaffirmed its commitment to continue partnering with the government and communities to support development projects in areas with the greatest need. He emphasized the Foundation's dedication to expanding projects in water, health and education


