1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The **Lalji Foundation** is a non-profit organization committed to improving the lives of underserved communities across Tanzania through impactful and sustainable development programs. The Foundation works to address fundamental social challenges by investing in clean water access, education, women's empowerment, health, and humanitarian assistance.

Recognizing that access to basic services is essential for community development, the Foundation has implemented numerous water projects, including boreholes and shallow wells, in rural areas where clean water is scarce. These initiatives have helped reduce the burden of water collection, improve health outcomes, and support economic activities within local communities.

Changarawe Village is located in Masanze Ward, Kilosa District, in the Morogoro Region of Tanzania. The village is part of the agricultural heartland of Kilosa District, an area characterized by fertile plains, seasonal rivers, and a rural economy largely dependent on farming and livestock keeping. Historically, the area developed as an agrarian settlement, with local communities relying on the cultivation of staple crops such as maize, rice, cassava, and beans. Like many villages in Kilosa District, Changarawe's growth has been closely linked to agriculture, which remains the primary source of income and livelihood for most households.

The donation of a shallow well by the **Lalji Foundation** represents an important milestone in the village's development history. By improving access to safe and reliable water, the project contributes to better health outcomes, reduced time spent collecting water, increased school attendance among children, and enhanced economic productivity for families in Changarawe Village.

- **Improved Hygiene and Sanitation:** A dependable water supply encourages better hygiene practices, including regular handwashing, cleaning, and sanitation, which further improves public health.
- **Greater Community Well-being** The project reduces daily hardships associated with water scarcity and improves the overall quality of life for residents.
- **Empowerment of Women and Girls.** By easing the burden of water collection, the project gives women and girls more opportunities to participate in education, entrepreneurship, and community activities.
- **Strengthened Community Development** The availability of clean water supports broader development efforts and creates a foundation for future improvements in health, education, and economic growth.
- **Long-Term Sustainability and Resilience,** the shallow well provides a sustainable water source that helps the community better withstand seasonal water shortages and changing environmental conditions.

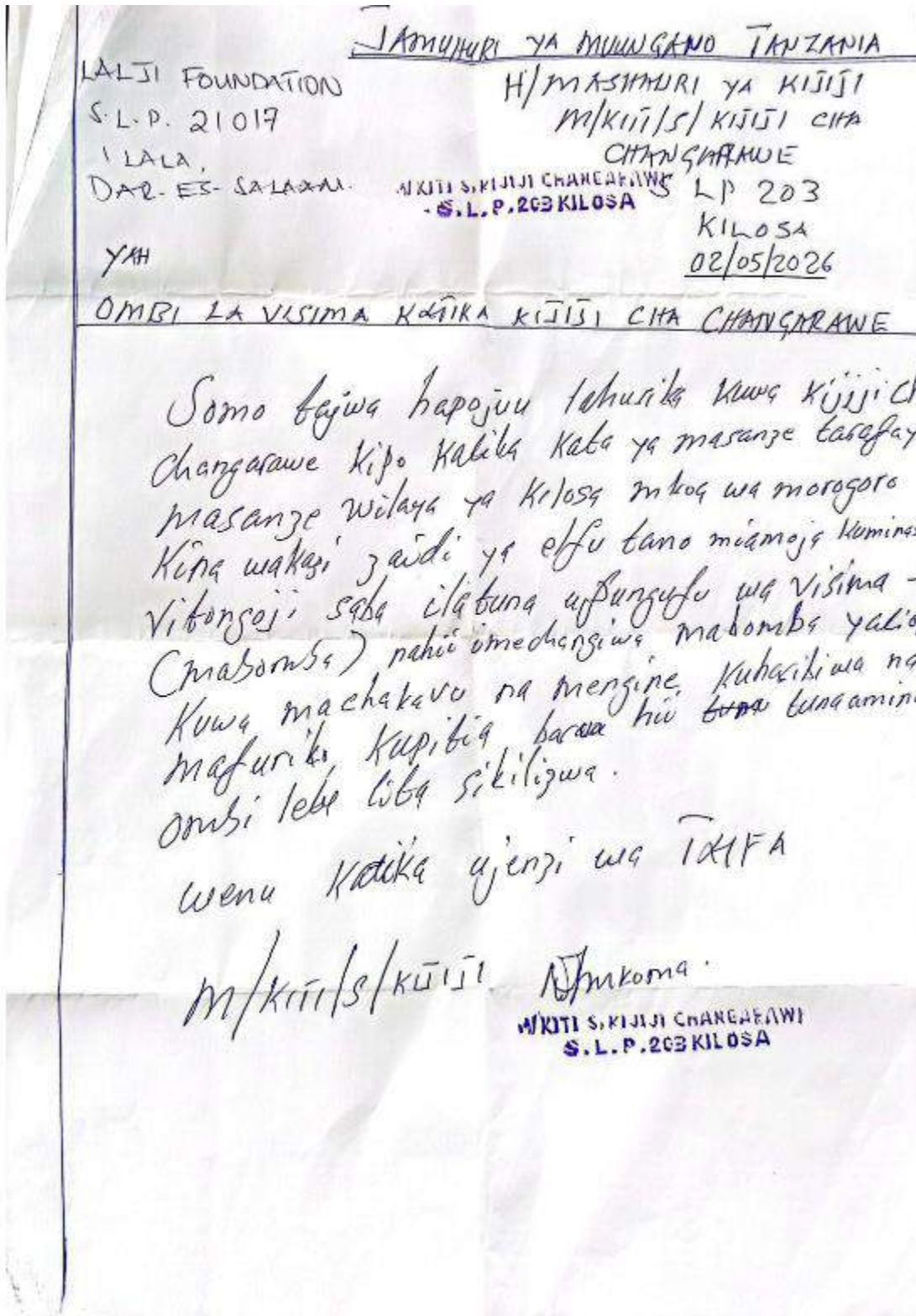
